

Cookie Policy

To ensure your privacy, we hereby inform you that on the website of DIA RETAIL SPAIN, S.A.U., (hereinafter, "DIA SPAIN"), located at the URL www.diacontribuye2020.com, we use cookies and similar mechanisms that allow us to facilitate the use of and navigation through the website, ensure access to certain functionalities and additionally, help us improve the quality of the page according to your browsing habits and styles.

1. What are "cookies"?

A cookie is a file downloaded onto your terminal (either a computer, smartphone or tablet) when you access a website and allow the owner of said site to store or retrieve certain information about multiple variables, such as the number of times the page has been visited by the user, identify the registered user, ensure user session while browsing the page, allow for safe and stable operations, etc.

As stated, cookies provide information about users' browsing habits and consequently may affect the privacy of the user's browsing habits; for this reason, we would like to provide you with the necessary information about the types of cookies used on our website, so you have full decision-making ability regarding the use of cookies and in relation to protecting your privacy.

In this regard, we hereby inform you that in order to use full web services and functionality, cookies must be enabled in the Internet browser. Likewise, we inform you that there are functionalities of the website the mere explicit use of which entails the activation of the corresponding cookies.

What types of "cookies" are there?

- Depending on the entity that manages the domain from which the cookies are sent, and processes the data that is obtained, two types can be distinguished:
 - o Proprietary cookies: those that are sent to your terminal device from our own equipment or domains.
 - o Third-party cookies: those that are sent to your terminal device from equipment or a domain of another collaborative entity.

- Depending on the time frame that they remain stored in the customer's browser, they can be:
 - o Session Cookies: These are a type of cookie designed and used to collect and store data while the user accesses a website. As the name indicates, these cookies are stored in the terminal until the user's browsing session is finished.
 - o Persistent cookies: those cookies stored for a given time on the user's terminal device, to which the processor has access when the user connects to their website.

- According to the purpose for which the data obtained is processed:
 - o Technical cookies: those cookies that are required for the use of the website and for the provision of services.

- Personalisation Cookies: those that allow the user to access the service with some pre-defined general features based on a number of criteria in the user's terminal (language, browser type...).
- Analytical cookies: this is a type of cookie designed and used for tracking and analysing user behaviour. This type of cookie provides the website holder with measurement of the activity on the website via aggregated or statistical information.
- Advertising Cookies: these cookies are designed and used to manage, as effectively as possible, the advertising spaces that, if any, have been included in the website, application or platform from which the requested service is provided based on criteria such as the content edited or the frequency with which advertisements are displayed.

2. What “cookies” do we use on this Website?

Below, we will provide you with information about the type of cookies used on the DIA SPAIN website and the purpose of these cookies:

Technical and personalisation cookies:

3. How to manage “cookies”?

Taking into account the information provided through this Cookie Policy, below we provide information on how you can manage the cookies used on the DIA SPAIN website through the various options provided by the most common browsers (Explorer, Firefox, Chrome and Safari).

If you prevent the installation of all the cookies on the website, some functionality of the website, as well as some content, may be affected. The user may consent to or reject the use of cookies at any time by accessing the configuration panel.

4. How do I view and delete “cookies”?

All browsers offer the user the ability to search for and view the cookies that are installed on a certain website, obtain information regarding the duration of the cookies, and the ability to remove them as indicated in the next section.

To restrict or block the cookies, you will need to modify the browser settings you use in your terminal, whether computer, smartphone or tablet. Generally, browsers provide the following configuration options in relation to the installation of cookies:

- Your browser declines all cookies and therefore no cookie is installed from any website in your terminal.
 - Your browser alerts you before the cookie is installed to decide whether or not you will accept it.
 - Your browser only rejects third-party cookies from the websites you visit, but not those used by the website you are browsing.
 - The private mode browsing option by which cookies are installed in the terminal but are automatically deleted when you finish browsing the web page:
